DOCUMENT #1 - REQUIRED

On a separate paper, please provide your resume. It should include:

- School activities in which you have participated. Describe level of participation and dates (month/year).
- Activities outside of school in which you have participated. Describe level of participation and dates (month/year).
- Community service/volunteer activities outside of school in which you have participated. Describe level of participation and dates (month/year).
- Any work experience. Include dates (month/year)
- Any other activities/life experiences that reflect positively on you. Describe your level of participation and dates (month/year).

DOCUMENT #2 - REQUIRED

On a separate paper, write a brief autobiography in which you address how you have grown from your life experiences. Instead of writing something new, you may attach a personal statement or essay from a college application which addresses how you have grown from your life experiences.

DOCUMENT #3 – OPTIONAL

To be considered for financial need based scholarships, attach a copy of a FAFSA document that indicates your Expected Family Contribution (EFC).

- Please DO NOT submit a copy of your FAFSA application form.
- If you choose not to submit the EFC, you will still be considered for merit-based scholarships.

REMINDERS TO APPLICANTS: To avoid technical rejection of your application, check off the following:

** Incomplete applications will not be considered. **

- [] Answered all questions.
- [] Attached resume detailing topics listed above.
- [] Attached a brief autobiography, personal statement, or essay addressing the topic detailed above.
- [] If applying for financial need based scholarships, attached a FAFSA document that indicates your EFC.
- [] Signed and dated in the spaces below by both student AND parent/guardian.
- [] Mail the application to ECSA, P.O. Box 54, Ellington, CT 06029. It MUST be postmarked no later than Friday April 8, 2022 or it will not be considered. Only mailed applications will be accepted.
